At home please: Give children

Literacy

In class we are:

Reading: Sustaining engagement with storytelling for longer periods of time and using symbols / Aided Language Displays to join 2 symbols together / build sentences. We will be reading the sensory story 'The Wliderness' by Steve Mc Carthy.
