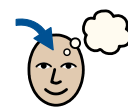

Physical Development

In class: During **RE** we will be exploring the sensory aspects of wudu in islam and exploring prayer from Christian practice.

During **science** we will be looking at electrical circuit and things that use electricity such as buzzer, light on/off.

During **History** and **Geography** we are looking at how circus changed over time and circus around the world.

In **Maths** we are looking at sensory number rhymes focusing on 'more' and looking at shapes and size small/big.

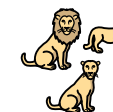
We will encourage pupil to use all their senses where possible. We will also give opportunity for number, positional language and encourage friendly sabotage in familiar routines to allow pupil opportunities to communication something is wrong/different.

At home please: Look at circus rhymes song and count together balls, hats, hoops and group them in sizes.

In class: During **PE** we will be exploring circus skills and develop gross motor skills and completing physio plans.

Fine motor skill: We will be exporting different textures and methods during creative art which support our fine motor skills. We will also be using tools and fingers to mark make onto: soil, dough, syrups

At home please: Follow physio plan and encourage your child to explore variety movement.
