### **Communication and Language**

In class we are exploring how we can use sounds in different ways, linked to the farm. We are making animal sounds, listening to farm-related noises, and using our voices or instruments to copy and create sounds.

At home, please encourage your child to make animal sounds or copy sounds they hear in stories or videos. Use household objects to explore different noises and talk about what the sounds remind them of.

#### **Physical Development**

In class we are developing our multi-skills by practising how to control our bodies in different ways. This includes kicking, throwing, and improving our overall body coordination through fun and active games.

At home, please encourage your child to be active by throwing and catching soft balls, kicking a ball outside, or playing movement games that help them practise coordination and balance.

#### **PSED**

In class we are learning about the different stages of the human life cycle and what happens to us as we grow. We are exploring key events in each stage, such as being a baby, child, teenager, and adult.

At home, please talk to your child about how people grow and change over time. Look at family photos together and talk about different life stages and special milestones like birthdays, starting school, or learning to walk.

# **Understanding the World**

In class we are learning about farm animals and their babies. We are exploring their names, what they eat, where they live, and how cows contribute to greenhouse gases.

At home, please talk with your child about different farm animals and their babies, look at pictures or books together, and watch short videos about farm life.

## <u>Maths</u>

In class we are learning to categorise objects based on different characteristics such as colour, size, and shape. We are also observing changes in different objects and exploring how things can be grouped or sorted.

At home, please encourage your child to sort everyday items by colour, size, or shape (e.g. socks, toys, buttons). Talk about how things are the same or different and notice any changes in objects like ice melting or fruit ripening.
